

ORDINANCE #11
TOWN OF SCHROON

PARKING ORDINANCE

That pursuant to the authority of Town Law, Section 130, the following parking regulations are adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Schroon, Essex County, New York.

Section 1. MOTOR VEHICLE DEFINED. For the purpose of this Ordinance, motor vehicle shall be defined as "an automobile or any vehicle powered by a motor, such as a truck or bus".

Section 2. PARKING ZONES DURING SNOW REMOVAL OPERATIONS. No motor or other vehicles of any kind shall be allowed or permitted to park on the public roads, streets or highways in the Town of Schroon between the hours of 1 A.M. and 7 A.M. during snow removal operations.

Section 3. SNOW REMOVAL OPERATIONS DEFINED: Snow removal operations shall be deemed to be required during and for a period of 24 hours after any snow storm.

Section 4. PENALTIES:

A. Any motor vehicle parked on any public road, street or highway in violation of this ordinance, may be, or caused to be, towed away by the Town of Schroon at the expense of the owner of the motor vehicle involved in the violation.

B. In addition, the owner of the motor vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine in an amount not to exceed \$25.00.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
