Creative Aging: a popular program returns to the Schroon Lake Library

The very popular, Creative Aging for those 55+, program will continue with a new session: *Memoir Writing—It's Your Story—Tell it!*

Join us for this 8-week workshop which will be offered Tuesday mornings, March 18th through May 6th from 10 a.m.—12 noon. Classes will be held in the downstairs meeting room in the town hall.

This free, grant-funded program allows participants to draw on their untapped creativity while also building relationships with neighbors in a relaxed environment. Each week participants will gather to remember, reflect, and write. During the sessions, participants will be guided through the writing process. From getting the creative juices flowing to style and revision, all topics will be covered.

The series will be lead by Carol

Gregson, writer and artist, author of *Leaky Boots* and *Wet Socks*.

The sessions are organized around the premise that we all have stories to tell—we just need to make the time to tell them. If you have always thought, "Someone should write this down," when listening to family stories, or when thinking about your own life, this workshop is for you. If you have always kept a journal, and want to try another approach to writing about your life, this workshop is for you. 
