**RESOLUTION # 75 HONORING
TROOPER LAWRENCE P. GLEASON
WITH A MEMORIAL SIGN TO BE POSTED AT THE CHARLEY HILL ROAD
OVERPASS BRIDGE (I-87)
IN THE TOWN OF SCHROON**

The following resolution was offered by Councilman Gero, who moved its adoption.

WHEREAS, twenty years ago, on February 11, 2002, Trooper Lawrence P. Gleason, New York State Police Department, was killed in the line of duty while responding to a domestic violence complaint; and

WHEREAS, as a result of his ultimate sacrifice and valor, Trooper Gleason was posthumously awarded the Brummer Award, the highest award by the New York State Police; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Schroon is desirous of installing a memorial sign at the Charley Hill Road Bridge Overpass on I-87 in the Town of Schroon honoring Trooper Lawrence P. Gleason.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Schroon Town Board hereby requests for legislation be passed pursuant to Highway Law Sections 342-344 authorizing the New York State Department of Transportation to install a memorial sign at the Charley Hill Road Bridge overpass on I-87 in the Town of Schroon to honor Trooper Lawrence P. Gleason; and

The resolution was seconded unanimously, and duly adopted.

Vendors Permit for Kayak and Paddle Boards in Park

Supervisor Wood stated the Schroon Lake Marina and the Barkeater Shop would like to rent Kayaks and Paddle Boards down by the beach area. The Board will look at possible places to put them and the Vendors will get back to the Board with ideas they would like to do.
