Councilperson Donaldson stated, just to be clear, we are going to do the excavating and the flagging as well as provide the barrels and the cones, to help save some expenses?

Councilperson Gero stated, correct.

Ethan Thompson stated; I just wanted to give you an update and some figures. I walked the sidewalks and I think we want to have a plan for next year. For example, I walked from Windsor to Leland and it was 690 feet, 30% of the side walks there are 4 feet wide and 70% is 5 feet wide. Most of this section needs to be replaced. At present, at a budget of \$20,000, we would be able to cover 300 feet of that sidewalk replacement. I just wanted to give you an idea of what we can expect for a budget and how far that money will go. Bare in mind as well, that's only for one side of the street.

Councilperson Donaldson stated; what are the regulations?

Ethan Thompson stated; regulation is a minimum of 4 feet as long as you have a 5-foot-wide passing zone every 200 feet. For a driveway entrance the apron has to meet the minimum requirements for slope. We have 18,900 feet of side walk, roughly. Based at doing 300 feet a year for replacement, it would be 62 years before we replaced all of them. That's based on lineal feet, not square footage of replacement feet.
